#### DMFT Community Consultation in Korba, Chhattisgarh



The last regional consultation on DMFT, organised by Sarthak, Environics Trust and MIRA, was held in Korba, Chhattisgarh, at the Panchvati, Municipality Conference Hall, on 3rd September, to discuss the findings of the survey of 255 projects, conducted in Raigarh and Korba districts of Chhattisgarh.
