the United Nations Climate Change and hosted by the Johor state government in collaboration with the Government of Malaysia.





"Out of the Shadows: Australia's Fossil Fuel Footprint", that provides an overview and analysis of Australian Stock Exchange (ASX) listed extractive companies' global fossil fuel footprint. The report, makes a series of recommendations on increasing transparency



and reporting on reserves, embedded emissions, price sensitivity, break even prices closure liabilities and transition plans. It calls for an end in government funding fossil fuels and a halt to any new approvals for fossil fuel projects.
