

Ethics and Climate Change, mines

EIA Resource and Response Centre. He



was also a founding Executive Member of the National Green
Tribunal Bar Association. He was highly regarded for his monumental
contributions to various environmental, social and human rights

issues from a people's perspective, particularly the vulnerable communities.
