Coalition Updates.

• Intergenerational Equity requires treating Mineral Sale Proceeds (MSPs) as Non-Debt Capital Receipts (NDCR). EAS Sarma (Secretary-Economic Affairs in the Ministry of Finance during 1999-2000) and Rahul Basu (Research Director at Goa Foundation), have written a letter to the 16th Finance Commission, arguing for a change in the way India manages its public finances."The present treatment of royalties and other mineral receipts is leading to the consumption of our mineral wealth at the cost of our future generations. This is unsustainable. On a global basis, this error incentivizes consumption of our fossil fuels, which will inevitably lead to a collapse of civilization. On the other hand, nothing is lost if we extract more slowly. The minerals are still in the ground and will be of use to India's future generations. And if we do extract the minerals, it is only fair that the proceeds be saved in an endowment fund for the benefit of all future generations.

We are only converting inherited capital into a perpetuity, while strictly maintaining the ownership structure."
